COMMUNITY INVESTMENTS



\$19.5 Million in Community Development Block Grant funding invested throughout Los Angeles County for activities such as:

- \$650,000 for Public Facilities
- \$383,000 for Senior Programs
- \$9.5 Million for Housing Programs
- \$1.3 Million for Special Needs Services
- \$2.7 Million for Economic Development Activities

\$7.4 Million received for HOME Investment Partnerships Program activity throughout Los Angeles County

3,662 New Affordable Housing Units under construction throughout Los Angeles County

25 First-Time Homebuyers approved for a new home throughout Los Angeles County

RENTAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAMS

21,052 Families supported with Housing Vouchers through Rental Assistance Programs

2,293 Veterans assisted with Veterans Affairs Supportive Housing Vouchers

4,903 Families on the Waiting List for Section 8 Housing Choice Vouchers

91% Voucher Utilization supported by 102% budget utilization for Rental Assistance Programs
