Community Development Block Grant	HUD	\$13,668,315	CDBG funds can be used to prevent, prepare for, and respond to the coronavirus pandemic. Additionally, the CARES Act provides CDBG grantees with flexibilities that make it easier to use this fund for coronavirus response, but we must meet the low- and moderate-income benefit. CARES Act CDBG funds are currently being used for the following activities: Emergency Rental Assistance; Emergency Mortgage Relief; Business Assistance, including assistance to micro-enterprises; Emergency Utility Assistance; Grab-N-Go meals, home delivered meals and other food programs for families and senior citizens; Senior Care packages (delivered or grab-n-go) that includes food and other essential items; Virtual programming including educational and recreational activities for youth and seniors; Homeless care services, including food, shelter, bathing facilities, counseling, and case management; Hygiene stations; and Fair Housing Services.
Emergency Solutions Grants - Fed	HUD	\$6,605,000	ESG funds must be used for the benefit of unsheltered homeless, sheltered homeless, and those at risk of homelessness.
Emergency Solutions Grants - Fed-New Formula	HUD	\$62,445,900	ESG funds must be used for the benefit of unsheltered homeless, sheltered homeless, and those at risk of homelessness.
Emergency Solutions Grants - State	State	5,224,000	ESG funds must be used for the benefit of unsheltered homeless, sheltered homeless, and those at risk of homelessness.
Mainstream	HUD	\$391,158	An additional 24 Mainstream Vouchers are allocated through CARES Act. The housing assistance payment under this allocation may be used in response to coronavirus only for incremental assistance for Mainstream voucher eligible families that include non-elderly person(s) with disabilities.
Housing Choice Voucher Admin	HUD	\$5,250,860	Supplemental administrative fee during the period that the program is impacted by coronavirus. This includes necessary upgrades to information technology and computer systems to enhance telework capacities and overtime pay to carry-out HCV Program responsibilities.
Public Housing Operation Subsidy	HUD	\$1,435,272	COVID 19 related expenses for public housing portfolio to include rental losses, building expenses, IT upgrades, overtime pay for staff to carry-out program operation.
