Meeting Summary

Housing Task Force Updates

Multifamily Finance Super Notice of Funding Availability (NOFA)

- California Department of Housing and Community Development (HCD) announced the release of \$101 million to help rapidly rebuild affordable multifamily rental housing in the fire-impacted region of Los Angeles County.
- Application materials were made available on July 21, 2025. Applications must be submitted no later than August 21, 2025, at 4:00 p.m.
 - Awards will be disseminated during November after applications have been reviewed. If funds remain after the first round of awards has been completed, the second award announcements will be made beginning in December.
- Developers must begin construction within 180 days of the award and utilize land near the fire perimeters to support the prioritization of wildfire-displaced families.

CalAssist Mortgage Fund

- Applications opened on June 12, 2025, to support displaced residents with their mortgage bills by awarding three months of payments, up to \$20,000.
- The first round of awards had been disseminated to applicants last week. There is a tight budget for media coverage of the Mortgage Relief Grant, requesting that attendees share information broadly to maximize outreach to those impacted by wildfires.
- 1,200 people have applied for the fund and are awaiting determination. In a month, there will be better statistics on the type of applications received whether most applicants were eligible survivors, ineligible, or not a true wildfire survivor.

Affordable Housing Work Group

- The Affordable Housing Work Group conducted a kickoff meeting in June 2025, with attendees from the Department of Regional Planning (DRP), Department of Public Works (DPW), and philanthropic organizations.

- A meeting will be held on Thursday, August 07, 2025, to elaborate on the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG-DR) and what action needs to be taken once the grant is approved by Congress.
- The grant will address the needs and gaps in infrastructure that support new housing developments and rebuilds focused on creating affordable housing for displaced residents.

Reverse Mortgage Work Group

- Work Group Upcoming Workshops & Events:
 - **August 16, 2025:** The California Department of Insurance (DOI) will be presenting on Homeowner Insurance for Eaton wildfire impacted residents.
 - **September 13, 2025:** Untied Policyholders in collaboration with lawyers from the State Bar will provide a presentation to support informing wildfire survivors on the process of hiring a lawyer.
 - **October 2025:** Certified Access Specialist (CASp) consultants will facilitate a workshop on ADA accessibility and senior rebuilding with intent for prolonged independent living.
- Workshops and events will be suspended during November and December 2025 due to the holiday season before restarting in January 2026.

Recovery Workshop Debrief

Recovery Event Overview

- The LA Wildfire Recovery Partnership Workshop was facilitated by Cal OES and FEMA and held at the Kaiser Permanente facility in Pasadena on July 09, 2025.
- Over 100 organizations attended including various county, state, and federal stakeholders, as well as philanthropic donors.
- Discussed the navigation of cross-cutting issues, and the holistic approach to recovery.
- Covered lessons learned from previous disasters, the importance of recovery planning, safety and affordability in recovery, and long-term affordability.
