COVID-19 SAFETY PROTOCOLS

Use of Personal Protection Inspectors, tenants, and owners, must wear a mask while the inspection is being conducted. Inspectors are also required to wear other LACDA-approved personal protective equipment. (i.e., mask, gloves, shoe covers). **Reporting an Illness** If you have a fever, cough, or flu-like symptoms, prior to or on the day of your inspection, you must promptly notify the LACDA or inform your Inspector so the inspection can be rescheduled. The Los Angeles County Development Authority (LACDA) has implemented protocols to ensure the safety of tenants and agency staff before and during an in-person inspection. All parties must adhere to the following protocols:

Social Distancing

Anyone in the unit must maintain a 6-foot distance between themselves and the Inspector. Tenants must also minimize the number of family members in the home while the inspection is being conducted.

Ensuring Access

Tenants must provide clear and immediate access throughout the unit so that the Inspector can test windows, emergency release systems, and outlets. This will ensure a safe and expedient inspection.
