FEEDING LOS ANGELES COUNTY

Los Angeles County has many types of food resources for families in need of support. If you are facing food insecurity and need assistance, please visit the 211LA website for further information and resources.

If you are age 60+, an individual with disabilities, and/or a dependent adult, you may be eligible to have free meals delivered from the County's Elder Nutrition Program; call 800-510-2020 to request this service. If you prefer to pay for your own groceries, and have them delivered to you, call 888-863-7411 for the County's Critical Delivery Service.



COVID-19 CORNER

Getting vaccinated is one of many steps you can take to protect yourself and others from COVID-19. Protection from COVID-19 is critically important because for some people, it can cause severe illness or death.
