



NEW ONLINE RENT CAFÉ PORTAL COMING JANUARY 2022

The Los Angeles County Development Authority (LACDA) is moving towards going paperless and conducting the majority of business online through the new online Rent Café Portal.

Accessing the new online Rent Café Portal will be as simple as logging into your email. The online Rent Café Portal will allow you to:

- Complete your annual re-examination online;
- Submit changes in income and family composition; and
- View inspection information.

If you already have an existing Portal account, you will have to re-register for the new online Rent Café Portal. Notifications will be mailed soon with additional information.

Ms. Mitchell attributes being housed to Exodus Recovery, Inc., and the LACDA stating that these agencies saved her life.

Ms. Mitchell can now enjoy her home where her granddaughter is able to spend time with her safely. Ms. Mitchell looks forward to opening her front door daily as a reminder to remain strong and encourage others.
