### LA COUNTY RENT REGISTRY: What You Need to Know

The Los Angeles County Rent Stabilization and Tenant Protections Ordinance (RSTPO) is a local law that limits annual rent increases (rent-stabilized units only) and provides tenants protections from evictions without just cause for residential rental units in the unincorporated areas of Los Angeles County. The Los Angeles County Development Authority (LACDA) is in compliance with the Rent Registry requirement RSTPO section 8.52.050 (B) and may be required to deny a rent increase for a rental unit in the future, if it does not meet the rent registry requirements.
